Request specific songs if you wish-especially those written by Randy--and ask them to play more of his stuff in general, if you like. But write. And call, especially Fega and Symphony Sid (and don't bother to write them, unless you really feel like going all-out).

If some nice lady would like to conduct a little campaign it might be helpful-that is, call repeatedly, always requesting Randy (and Booker, who he does play), and complementing him on the show, etc. But don't let him know you know Randy!
