Yes, Randy Weston is tall, six-feet-seven in fact, a giant of a man gentle in demeanor with a heart-warming smile and a gift for jazz that is prodigious. His co-artists tenor saxophone, trumpet, string bass, jazz drums and conga drums — respond electrically to his extraordinary artistic personality and thus help create jazz-making of enormous impact on their audiences.

A performance by the Randy Weston Sextet is much more than entertainment: it is a basic musical experience worthy of the concert hall. The Sextet is available all season either for concerts of original music, composed mainly by Randy Weston, or in a survey of jazz from African rhythms to the avant-garde of the 1960's, interpolated with Weston's brief but expressive commentary, for he is as much an authority on jazz as he is its practitioner.
