Discussion of the minicases related to the **Esophagus (Oct. 28)**, **Stomach (Oct. 30)**, **Intestine (Nov. 13)**, **Pancreas (Nov. 20)**, and **Liver (Dec. 9)** will take place in small groups lead by either Dr. Gupta, Dr. Liu, Dr. Sack, or Dr. Shannahan. An answer guide will be posted to Canvas following these five sessions. **A class discussion of the minicases on Malabsorption (Nov. 6) and Liver Disease (Dec. 11) will be led by Dr. Dan Chung. Students should read and think about the cases prior to each session. Preparation and participation in minicase discussions will be a component of the course grade and evaluation.**
