The New Zealand Union of Students' Associations, alongside our partners and the Academic Quality Agency, have run annual Student Voice Summits since 2016. Previous Summits, held separately for universities and ITP's, have focused on student voice in academic quality.

You shall be presenting in the section **Global Student Perspectives**, which shall focus on the wider context of student representation across the world.

The session is scheduled for **Day Two, 19th November (20th November in NZ) from 4.30p.m. to 5.00p.m. Boston time (9.30a.m. to 10.00a.m. NZT) via Zoom**. A draft outline of the programme has been supplied also, which provides a breakdown of the day and the objectives of the Summit.

We anticipate that the Summit will be attended by over 100 existing and emerging student leaders, as well as key sector officials and staff.
