U.S. Government Regulations for Which Associated Regulatory Impact Analyses Applied the Social Cost of Carbon (or Methane) to Changes in GHG Emissions 2008-2019

The authors constructed a database of all economically significant U.S. government final regulations issued by executive branch agencies for which the associated regulatory impact analysis applies the social cost of carbon or social cost of methane to changes in greenhouse gas emissions expected under the regulation (Table SI-1). As a starting point, the authors drew from Appendix Table A1 of (1) for rules over 2008-2013 and the compilation by (2) over 2008-2015. The authors determined if the listed rules applied the social cost of carbon and if the rules were determined "economically significant" under Executive Order 12866. The authors corroborated the rules from these lists by reviewing the published regulation in the Federal Register and the annual report to Congress from the Office of Management and Budget on the benefits and costs of federal regulations. The authors expanded the database of rules through 2019 with those included in the more recent Office of Management and Budget reports to Congress.

Table SI-1 presents each regulation, including its date of publication in the Federal Register, formal title, promulgating agency or agencies, regulatory identification number (RIN – and in a few cases, its secondary RIN, denoted RIN_2), and Federal Register citation with hyperlink to the PDF of the regulation.

U.S. Government agencies promulgated 60 final regulations over 2008-2019 that applied the social cost of carbon or social cost of methane to expected changes in greenhouse gas emissions in their associated regulatory impact analysis.
